

# ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

## CITY OF GONZALES GONZALES, TEXAS 2021 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

Separate sealed bids addressed to the City of Gonzales (OWNER) clearly labeled **“ATTENTION: CITY SECRETARY, 2021 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS”** will be received at Gonzales City Hall, 820 St. Joseph Street, Gonzales, Texas 78629, until **2:00 o'clock p.m. on Thursday, April 29th, 2021**, and then publicly opened and read aloud immediately.

This project includes the reclaiming with cement stabilization approximately 2,000 SY pavement, approximately 14,500 SY of pavement milling, installation of approximately 30,000 SY PetroMat and the installation of approximately 30,000 SY of 2" HMAC over entire length and width of project streets (St. Lawrence Street, Church Street and Sydler Street) and replacement of approximately 2,500 LF of curb & gutter and;

This project also includes the installation of approximately 5,830 SY of two course surface treatment over entire length and width of reclaimed and cement stabilized streets including replacement of all curb & gutter (+/-3600 LF) and driveway approaches along Oakland Street and Ridgemont Street.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, Bid Proposal, Bid Bond, Agreement, Performance and Payment Bonds, General Conditions, Special Conditions, Notice of Award, Notice to Proceed, Technical Specifications and Plans, together with any Addenda are available at Doucet & Associates, Inc., 829 N. Each bid shall be accompanied by a cashier's check or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total actual bid price payable without recourse to the City of Gonzales, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract and execute required performance and payment bonds.

The contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; however, the right is reserved, as the interests of the OWNER may require, to reject any and all bids, and to waive any informality or minor defects in bids received. Bids may be held by the OWNER for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the opening for Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.

There will not be a pre-bid conference. Contractors shall make their own individual site inspections and/or investigations to make themselves aware of existing conditions/issues. Failure to make adequate observations, investigations and/or ask questions prior to bidding shall not be grounds for requesting additional work or services. Questions shall be forwarded to J.
